2-year-olds (must be 2 by the first day of camp)

3-year-olds (must be 3 by the first day of camp)

4-year-olds - 13 years

Classes are grouped by Pre-K - 6th grade determined on the last school year camper completed.

(For example: camper 1 completed first grade prior to camp, then camper 1 will be in a first-grade class group.)

Registration and Session Fees

**Registration fees and session fees are non-refundable.

PLEASE NOTE: KidsKamp is financially self-supportive. First Baptist Church **does not** provide any financial assistance to camp. Our budget which includes facilities, counselors, salaries, activities, and supplies are based on planned attendance; therefore, we require payment based on scheduled days.

Each child must be registered for camp before attending. Registration fees must be paid at the time of registration. Registration fees are non-refundable. Registration fee is \$50.00 per child which will include a free t-shirt while supplies last.

KidsKamp does not discriminate on the basis of religion, race, color, creed, gender, national origin, ancestry, handicap, or disability.

Failure of a parent to comply with the requested information or to follow the policies of KidsKamp may result in the child having to withdraw from camp.
