Registration

Registration can be completed online at fbcslidell.org. Registration fees must be paid when registering. Registration fee s \$50.00 per child and includes one camp tee-shirt. Please make sure to include your child's size when registering. Each child must be registered separately. Registration fees are non-refundable. Please include an updated email address as we send information out by email before camp starts. Prior to the first day of camp, parents will be able to pick up a camp packet with their child's shirt in the welcome center at First Baptist.

An email will be sent out once those packets are ready.

Weekly Fees

Weekly fees are due the Friday prior to the following week and no later than Monday morning at drop off. Unless prior arrangements are made with the camp director you may not drop off your camper if account is not current. While KldsKamp is a ministry of First Baptist Church, we are not funded by the church. Camp is financially dependent on camp fees to cover salaries, lunches, snacks, activities, etc. Once camp begins, camp fees (registration fees and weekly fees) are non-refundable and may not be rolled over to the following week.

Fees can be paid in advanced by the week, month, or the full camp sessions, by check, money order, cash or card. Please note a 5% fee will be added to card payments.

Before care and After care

Before care is FREE, however you must register to utilize it for staffing purposes. A registration form will be provided in the camp packets.

After care is charged at 3.50 per hour per child. After care payments are due each Friday afternoon at pickup. If your child does not attend on Fridays, payment is due the last day your child attends that week. Any carried over balance must be paid on Monday or the first day your child attends camp the following week.

Drop off / Pick up

Two- and three-year-old campers *MUST* **be signed in and out in the preschool hall.** If you have an older sibling, please drop them off in the carline before bringing in your preschooler. At pick up, please sign your preschooler out then drive around to the back to pick up your older child from the carline.

Campers not staying for aftercare will need to be picked up in the carline. (except 2 and 3 year old's) The car **must have the white car tag** or the driver will be asked to park and come inside the gym to pick up. **NO EXCEPTIONS. This is for safety reasons.**

CARLINE ENDS PROMPTLY AT 3:15. At 3:15, campers will be placed in aftercare in the gym and will be charged aftercare fees.

If you arrive at camp after 8:45, please come to the camp office to sign your child in. Enter to the right of the gym in the preschool hall. Please ring bell if door is locked.

Breakfast/Lunch/ Snacks

We will still be offering a variety of breakfast options Monday – Friday until 8:45am.

Snacks are provided daily. Campers may also bring their own snacks if they choose.

Lunch options will be provided as follows:

Mondays - Bring your own lunch

Tuesday – Bring your own lunch

Wednesday - Hot dogs / chips / drink

Thursday - Pizza / desert / drink

Fridays - Bring your own lunch

Personal Belongings

It is impossible to keep up with every camper's shirts, shorts, socks, shoes, towels, etc. **PLEASE label your child's belongings**. While counselors do try to assist when needed, campers must be able to keep up with their things in their backpacks and it helps if things are labeled. **Water Slide Days**

We will let parents know in advance if we have a water slide day. Water slide weather forecast if they will or will not bring the slide. We do not make that decision. If they look at the weather (hourly) and rain is predicted they will call and let us know they are not coming. It ruins the slide to sit in the rain and we are still financially responsible. IF we plan a water slide day, please send your child to camp with their bathing suit on under their clothes. They will change out of their swimsuits afterwards.
