

Two- and Three-year-old campers



Dear Parents,

Thank you for inquiring about our little campers. While our little campers have a daily schedule, and routines, for some of our little campers, this will be their first experience away from mamma and it may take some adjustment for them. Please know that we will do everything we can to make them happy and have an enjoyable experience at camp. For most of our campers, if they cry a little, they are usually fine after a few minutes. With that said, please note that if there is ever a time when your child is unhappy or crying for a significant amount of time, we will call you to pick them up. The last thing we want is for your baby to cry and be unhappy.

Our two- and three-year-old classes will be limited per class.

Campers that register with an older sibling will get priority spots.

Two-year-olds must be two on the first day of camp.

Two- and three-year-olds must be signed in and out daily.

You may choose full-time or part-time.

Once we reach capacity, we will have a waiting list.

We prefer that our little campers not stay for aftercare. However, we do understand that working parents may need to utilize it. If you need before and / or aftercare, we must know in advance so that we can staff it specifically for those little ones.

If you have an older sibling, please drop them off FIRST in the back of the church in carline in the morning then drive around and park and walk your little one in. In the afternoon, please pick up your preschooler FIRST then drive around to the back to carline to pick up the older sibling(s).

Two- and three-year-old campers will need a mat or towel for rest time. If it is something that needs to be washed, it will be sent home weekly.

Please bring a backpack with a change of clothes, pullups, diapers, wipes, etc. to camp every day.

You may pack them their own snack if you choose. We do provide a snack daily.

You may send their own sippy cup each day; please put their name on it.
